Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by an individual identified as Mr Uvile Nombevu who claims to be the Nephew of the owner of the dogs.

I saw three dogs when I entered the property. The dogs were free roaming and laying in front of the house. When the dogs saw me they stood up and approached me. It was 2 Bloudhounds and 1 Greyhound x (female, adult, black/white).

I asked Uvile if I can go to the back of the proeprty and he agreed and accompanied me to the back. I saw the cage door is open and Uvile advised that the dogs are no longer kept in here and this is now just their shelter. They have decided to keep the dogs free roaming inside the property. There was also water available inside the cage/enclosure.

While walking back to the front of the house, more greyhound dogs approached me from the steet. I recognized these dogs as the ones that were initially at the SPCA. It was the 2 tan adult Greyhounds and another Bloudhound male. I asked Uvile where do they now come from and he said that they belong to other people but roam the streets and come visit their dogs as they know eachother. I am more of the opinion that all the dogs are now kept at the property, also depicting that they are in contravention of their notice issued by Law Enforcement as they are only allowed to have 2 dogs on the property. I will inform Office Christiaans of this as well.

I observed that they 1 Greyhound x, female, adult, black/white appears to be underweight but that the dog also appears to be pregnant. I asked Uvile if the dog was taken to a veterinarian recently to which he said no. I indicated to him that the dog appears to be underweight as the dog's rib cage and hip bones are visible, and that the dog might have an underlying medical condition as the other dogs on the property appear to be in fair condition.

Uvile understood and advised that he will inform the owner.

I issued a warning:
1. To take the Greyhound x, female, adult, black/white named "Dyango Lendya" for veterinary assesement and possible treatment.
