General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met by Nicole, the owner.

I observed 4x dogs in total.

The senior dog is kept on a runner, the runner is approximately 15m long, with a light chain, and swivel attached to the dogs material collar. The dog also has his own kennel. The dog appears to be in good condition.

The young puppy and white/tan male are free roaming inside the property. Both these dogs had full access to the garage which provides them with adequate protection against the weather elements. Both dogs appear to be in good condition.

The adult female dog (dog complaint is about) is temporarily kept inside an enclosure due to the dog being on heat and they dont want her to be covered. The enclosure is about 3m x 3m, with sufficient ventilation and adequate protection against the weather elements. The dog has water and is in good condition.

I discussed sterilization with the owner and she wants the dog sterilized but does not want anything to do with Langebaan Animal Care (the complainant) as they are apparently harassing them and she feels the way the shout at her is not acceptable. I advised the owner that I will speak with them with regards to having the female dog sterilized, but that we first have to wait for the dog to get over her heat period, as there are high risk involved if the dog is sterilized while being on heat. The owner understands and was very grateful.

As the enclosure is only temporary, and I feel the reason is valid I did not recommended an alternative confinement manner.

I will check in with the owner in about 2 weeks time to make sure the heat period has passed and arrange with LAC to assist with sterilization.
