General Report Comments: Upon arrival, no one appeared to be present as there was no response to my presence.

I observed the 3x horses that appear to be in fair condition. The 1x horse, THB, you can slightly see his ribcage, but not in a manner where immediate intervention is required. I saw several fresh droppings, indicating that the horse are indeed fed. There is water available and 3 sided sheltered structures which provides adequate protection against the weather elements. The current camp they are in does not have sufficient grazing, but I could not see the entire proximity of the camp and there is likely an area with additional roughage placed out that I could not see from where I was standing.

I called the complainant to find out what exactly is going on, as when I got to the office this morning I was advised that the complainant called back in and advised that we should cancel the complaint as they went to check and saw hay placed out for the horses, and that they are in fact fed. I also wanted to ask the complainant if she has the owner's contact details.

The complainant provided me with the owner's contact details, and I will call her to setup a meeting and discuss the matter. The complainant further advised that the THB was adopted by the current owner from THB rescue, and they feel the horse must look better. I advised that we dont get involved with adoption protocols from other entities and that they must intervene how they see fit. I advised the complainant that I am not currently concerned about the horses current BCS's but that I will have a discussion with the owner and monitor their weight over a 3month period. The complainant was very happy and satisfied with the course of action.
