General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner's sister, Bianca.

I approached the dog in question that is kept on the right side of the property in an enclosure. The dog is kept here to prevent the dog from roaming the street, as the dog cant see 100%. The dog has sufficient space in this area, the living area is clean. The dog has adequate protection against the weather elements, in the form of a wooden kennel. The dog has water and appears to have an acceptable body condition, 3/5.

When the dog approached me it appeared as if the dog's vision has improved since I last saw the dog as the dog was facing me when I was standing at the entrance of his enclosure, and was also looking at Bianca. The eyes are more open, however both eyes appear to be a milky color. No swelling or puss was observed around the eyes.

I asked Bianca if they managed to take the dog for veterinary treatment and she advised that he brother had not done so yet, as he is busy writing his final exams, he is in grade 12. Today is his final exam. She also mentioned that they do not have the financial means at this stage, but that her parents are being paid this weekend, and they will likely have the means to take the dog over the weekend.

I also advised that they contact Margi, from CARE St Helena Bay, as I know she assists people sometimes. Bianca advised that they know who Margi is, and that she will advise her parents of such.

The other dog was again not on the property, Bianca advised thay the dog is almost never at home during the day. I asked Bianca to describe the current state of the dog's injury and she said that the dog has scabs on where the injury was and that there is no blood or open wounds.

I asked her to please try and enclose this dog on Monday, for me to physically inspect the dog.

I issued a final warning:

1. To take the dog for veterinary assessment and possible treatment.
