I could see the dog from the gate and saw that he is kept on a chain on the right hand side of the property. The property's fence is rather low 1.2 m and I can only assume as to this is why the dog is chained. The chain the dog is on is pinned to the ground, and approsimately 3m long attached to the dog's material collar. The area where the dog is chained is large and a runner can easily be installed. The dog has access to his kennel, water and a clean living area. The dog appears to be in good condition with no veterinary or health concerns observed. I issued a warning: 1. Your property makes provision for the dog to be placed on a runner. Install a runner for the dog.
