The chain the dog is on is pinned to the ground, and approximately 3m long attached to the dog's material collar. The area where the dog is chained is large and a runner can easily be installed. The dog has access to his kennel, water and a clean living area. The dog appears to be in good condition with no veterinary or health concerns observed.
