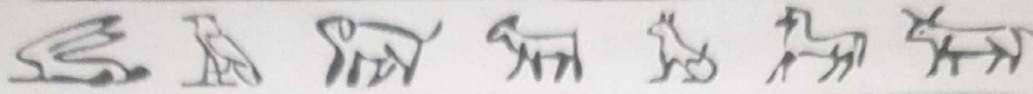

Patient: Moonlight, +/- 3 yr old mare

Clinical history:

I went out to see this patient, with the primary complaint of lameness. Owner was unsure which leg.

On presentation Moonlight was bright and alert. Clinical parameters all within normal limits, mucous membranes pink and moist, gut sounds very good and body condition score 3/5.

2/5 lameness on all 4. All 4 hoofs are completely worn down, very thin layer of hoof wall left and Moonlight is actually walking on the sole. This explains the lameness.

No bounding digital pulses, no swelling found on palpation.

I suggested they don't ride her for at least the next 8 weeks. Keep her in a smaller enclosure and get a farrier out as soon as there is enough new growth of the hoof.

I treated Moonlight with Meloxicam (10ml Vetcam IV) and left Previcox tablets with them to give 1/8 of 227mg tablet once a day.
