Mrs. Steenkamp explained to me why the dog is chained,because the property is not fenced. I told her that I understand but the way the dog is chained is not acceptable. The dogs water bowl was also empty and Mrs. Steenkamp went inside to fill the dogs bowl with fresh potable water. I also observed that the shelter of the dog is not adequate against the weather elements like rain. I explained all my concerns with Mrs. Steenkamp and issued warning W6042. Will follow up.
