General Report Comments: I visited Het Vlok farm in Riebeek Kasteel and conducted an inspection of the farmers' houses. All the dogs at these residences are free-roaming, and none were found to be tied up. The dogs I observed at the time of my visit were in an acceptable condition.

Most of the dogs on the farm have been sterilized. However, I was informed that some dogs wander onto neighboring farms, which has led to complaints.

I spoke to the complainant, Mrs. Vlok, and advised her that any unwanted dogs could be surrendered to the SPCA. She provided me with the contact information for the farm manager, Mr. Janrich Meyer. I subsequently contacted Mr. Meyer, who confirmed that arrangements would be made to bring any unwanted dogs to the SPCA.

Conclusion:

The farm dogs appear to be in an acceptable condition, and steps have been taken to address the concerns regarding roaming dogs by offering a surrender option to the SPCA. NFA UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE
