General Report Comments: I conducted a follow-up visit to Abbotsdale to verify compliance with the warning previously issued by Inspector Mathabela. Upon arrival, I was received by Mrs. Williams, who escorted me into the residence where the dog, named Brady, was being kept.

Mrs. Williams informed me that Brady was being housed indoors due to an injury. She presented veterinary treatment records prescribed by the Malmesbury Animal Hospital. Upon visual inspection, I observed that the wound had been treated. Brady appeared alert and friendly during the interaction. Mrs Williams told me that she does not know who injured her dog.

I advised that I would conduct a further follow-up to assess the ongoing condition of the wound. I went to the property of the "breeder" at number 128 5th Avenue to check on the welfare of those dogs. Mr Brent Hendricks were present and gave me access to do an inspection. Mr Hendricks claimed that he is not breeding any longer. There were 4 staffordshire terrier dogs on the property all in a good condition with no welfare concerns. I asked Mr Hendricks if he would be interested in sterilising the dogs and he said that he will be letting me know. He also said the all the neighbours are upset about the dogs of Mrs Williams that are roaming the streets. I told him that we have spoken to her about that but that he must also get Law Enforcement involved with that and provided him with the contact details. NFA
