CHECKLISTS

General Report Comments: Following up on a complaint regarding a white horse allegedly seen near the Silverstream turnoff in Mamre, I visited the area as described by the complainant. Upon arrival at the Silverstream turnoff in Mamre, I contacted the complainant telephonically. He advised that the horse was last seen approximately 1 km from the Mamre turnoff, near a section of fencing that appeared to be flattened.

I proceeded to drive the full stretch of road back toward the Swartland area and the turnoff to Darling . During this inspection, no white horse was visible along the road or in the immediate surroundings.

I then spoke with Mr. Beukes, who reported having seen the horse on the preceding Tuesday . He acknowledged that the horse may no longer be in the vicinity. Given the vastness of the area and the horse's mobility, it would be extremely difficult to locate the animal if it is not positioned close to the road.

Mr. Beukes understood the current limitations and accepted that, in the absence of a visual confirmation of the horse, there is no further action we can take at this point.

Conclusion:

No further action possible at this time due to the inability to locate the animal. Monitoring will continue, and any new sightings will be investigated accordingly.
