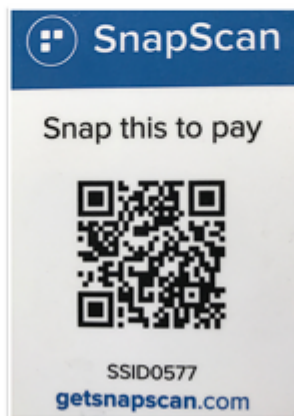

Hi Moyo,

The pigs in Ilingeethu, who have been at that location for several years, have not been resettled. Last week, we were made aware of sick pigs in the area. We contacted the State Vet's office in Malmesbury, who informed us that they were already aware of the situation. A sample had been taken and sent to Stellenbosch, and was subsequently

referred to Onderstepoort for testing.

The state vets had already visited the site and advised the owners not to bring in any new pigs and to keep the existing ones contained. According to the state vet's office, the municipality initially did not want to become involved in the disposal process due to concerns about potential health risks.

On Friday, Patrick visited the area to assess the situation and observed municipal workers digging holes and placing deceased pigs into them. At that stage, the pigs that remained did not show outward clinical signs of illness.

Patrick returned to the area yesterday and reported that the situation remained unchanged.

We followed up with the State Veterinary Services this morning, and they confirmed that they had received the test results today, which were positive. They had just concluded a meeting with the Swartland Municipality, whom they informed of the results and requested to make additional disposal sites available. They also indicated that they were en route to the affected area to provide further education and to apply lime (kalk) as part of their disease management measures. The state vet's office have confirmed that they are actively monitoring the situation.

If you think that there is anything else that we must do in this regard, please could you let me know. I just do not have any staff in that area at the moment.

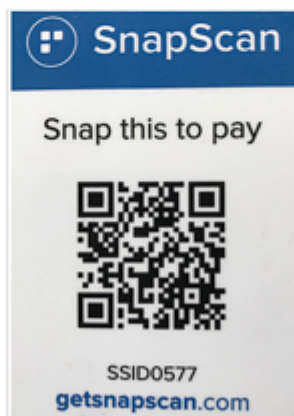
