General Report Comments: I saw 1x black and white pitbull male on a 8 meter long chain without a collar. The dog was tied with the raw chain around his neck. Water and shelter is available and the dogs body condition is acceptable. The owner came out and introduced himself as Stephan. Stephan told me that the dog Hitler keeps on breaking the collars. I explained to Stephan that he can use a piece of hose pipe and put the chain through the pipe so that the raw chain does not shave the dogs neck that could end up causing serious injuries. Stephan understands the consequences and told me that he will get a piece of pipe. I issued warning W6594. Will follow up.
