General Report Comments: When I arrived, the owner of the house was not present. A female introduced herself as Doreen Williams and informed me she is the owner of the mother of the dog in question Morne Williams. A sterilised black and white pitbull was present on the property. Mrs Williams gave me access to conduct an inspection.

Also on the property was a white and brown Jack Russell mix named Sky, running free, along with her approximately 9-month-old puppy named Peanut. Both Sky and Peanut are unsterilised. Upon opening the gate, both dogs ran down the street. Mrs Williams stated they usually run to the beach and return on their own. Mrs Williams will advise me if they are prepared to sterilise the two Jack Russel mix dogs.

I proceeded to the area where a dog named Bully was tied up. I asked Mrs Williams why Bully was tied, and she said Bully bites other dogs and jumps over the fence. I informed Mrs Williams that Bully may not be kept in that condition. I instructed her to clean the living area, place Bully on a proper running chain, ensure that food and water bowls are kept in the shade and not in direct sunlight, and to repair the kennel.

A warning notice, number W6951, was issued to address the above concerns. Mrs Williams refused to sign the warning but took the notice and stated she would hand it to her son. I then left the property.

I contacted the complainant, Mrs de Lange, who had offered to donate a kennel for Bully. I advised her that the donation should only proceed once the owner has complied with the warning. Mrs de Lange agreed.

I will follow up in 7 days to verify compliance with the warning issued.
