Collar around the neck was observed. Water and shelter is also available. I don't know why the dog is on a chain because there were no people at home. The property is also not fully fenced and this might be the reason why the dog is on a chain. I issued warning W6961 to get adequate treatment for example Simparica to treat the skin condition and to mix puppy food with the adult dog food so that the dog can more protein as some adult dog food does not have that much nutrition as puppy food. Will follow up.
