General Report Comments: I first went to the property of Mrs Jody Baxter who is the complainant and she informed me that she saw Johan Pretorius insiting his dog a black + tan female x-breed named Princess. Mrs Baxter informed me that she saw Johan hiting the cat with a brick. She informed me that Johan ran away when she screamed at him and she took the cat to Bergzitch Animal hospital where the cat was treated and admitted. Mrs Baxter informed me that she went to house number 3 Ranier street where Johan Pretorius live with his parents and Mrs Baxter informed me that Johan admitted to insiting his dog attack the cat. Mrs Baxter the told me that Johan later came to her house in the company of a young colored girl and he denied hitting the cat and she said that Johan claimed that his dog leasch broke and the dog attacked the cat. I then went to house number 12A Riebeek street where the owner of the cat Ms Mary Speelman lives. She was at home and I observed the cat in question a female DSH tortoicel in color and a female German Sheperd dog. Ms Speelman informed me that she was only made aware of her cat injured via the community Whatsapp group and she went to the Bergzitch Animal Hospital where the cat was being treated . Ms Speelman's contact number is 0798614287. Ms Speelman informed me that she went to confront Johan but he denied hitting the cat. Ms Speelman informed me that Johan's father Mr Loui Pistorius agreed to pay the vet bill. The cat is in good healthy and I didn't observe any visible injuries. The dog's body condition is fair and acceptable. I then proceeded to house number 3 Ranier street where I met Johan,a young colored girl and Johan's mother Mrs Aneline Pretorius. There is 2 dogs,2 cats and a pigion at this property and all of them are in a fair and acceptable body condition. I asked Johan about the injured cat and he denied hitting the cat and he showed me a broken leasch. He informed me that the cat was attacked by his dog and I informed him that I saw the cat and there was no signs of biting on the cat's face but he denied. When I was at Ms Speelman I asked her to go to the police (SAPS) and make an affidavit but she informed me that she doesn't want to lay cruelty charges against Johan.
