I then asked her to show me her dog, I went inside the premises and there I observed a female brown&white Africanis named Baby, Baby was on a thin rope leash of 10 meters long, the reason she is tied is because she jumps the fence and goes to the male dogs, according to the owner.

Water was available, shelter was available, and living environment was cleaned.

The owner of the dog Mrs Miriam Nzongane she is a pensioner according to her, and her dog looks at least taken good care of, she thus said, that she doesn't want Baby to get pregnant as she won't be able to take care of too many dogs.

I educated the owner about sterilization, and she agreed to sterilize her dog, I then filled her with sterilization form and I did explain to her about the outcomes of sterilization and she did not have any problem with the outcomes. I then took the dog and brought it to the spca Darling to be sterilized at the veterinary clinic.
