General Report Comments: On my arrival, I did not find anyone available in the property. I observed through the fence, the same 2 horses since from the first investigation, both horses appeared physically looking good in condition with no veterinary problems or health concerns, water was available, and living environment was cleaned.

Shelter was available though it was not adequate/strong from natural hazards (such as rain and strong winds etc).

The owner did not comply to the notice to comply that I issued her, to: 1) close the shelter on the other 2 sides, 2) to make roofing adequately that the rain can not come through inside the shelter when it's raining.

While after i made a turn at the camp, my colleague Mrs Lorraine a receptionist of Darling SPCA, she contacted me that a lady by the name of Angelique Steyn contacted our office line from +27 66 149 4228 asking what does the spca wants on her horses camp, according to Mrs Lorraine. I then contacted the Mrs Angelique Steyn, she answered and I introduced myself to her, I explained to her my visit as the SPCA to her horses camp of which I did not gain a entry to the camp , for that I did only observed the animals(horses) and the shelter, all observed through the fence, she replied that it is too much for her now because she used R5000 to build the current shelter so far, and she won't be able to build anything more than she did so far, and there are lots of animal cruelty happening outside there but the spca is busy giving her and her daughter Mrs Anneke unnecessarily pressure because their horses are extremely in good condition.

She then said, does not wat to talk anymore further and I must also not contact her daughter Mrs Anneke, ifthe spca wants to talk to her as a mother from now on, the communication must be done via emails because she will now involve her lawyers, and she also said I am dealing with a wrong person(referring to herself), her email address is admin@soutenpeper.co.za of which sent via my work WhatsApp.
