The brown dog was on a 2 meters long static light chain with a collar under a tree with dog house opposite the gate side, and the other dog was on a 5 meters long static black light rope with a collar to the pole sleeping on a couch in the shelter for car parking.
Water was available.
Looking alternatively for spaces to put the dogs on a running wire in the yard, the yard looked very small because there are two cars occupying the space. The owner said they can't extend the chain of the dog under a tree because the dog will come through drive way.
