General Report Comments: On my arrival, i was welcomed by Mr Arendse, I observed a dog named Cody, Cody appeared physically looking good in condition with no veterinary problems or health concerns, shelter was available, water was available in a clean bowl, the dog was on a static chain of +-3 meters chain to a collar (soft green water pipe) not too tight around it's neck. The said he put a running wire but the dog was able to go further closer to the fence of which outside the property fence it's a space of pedestrians, sometime during the the following day the pedestrians were passing by as usual and the dog got close to the fence and barked at them and seems they got frightened and thrown stones on the dog and it got a minor wound of which it led to bleeding and suddenly stopped bleeding, and the dog was removed from a running wire back to the same static chain, said the owner Mr Arendse.

I then asked him to show me we're he put running wire, I then observed indeed that he put two steel pens down deep the ground giving a space of R5 meters distance from each other, one of a steel pen still had a barbed wire that he cut off, and the running wire he used was also there.

Mr Arendse said, he did remove the dog because he saw it was exposed to the danger from the pedestrians and he could not stand to see his dog getting hurt worse if what will happen to the dog if he is not around home.
