At the corner of the property and the complainant property divided by the fence opposite the horses shelter, there was droppings of the horses gathered at one spot at the corner, it looked like the owner of the horses everytime they clean horses droppings they gather the horses droppings in a spot so far at the corner as observed.

I then advised the complainant to lay a complain of "heath care risk waste nuisance" to Swartland Municipality on 0224879400. Because the spca enforce APA act in terms of the animals welfare , of which does not enforce the bylaw.

I will go back again on the 24 June 2026 to do a follow up to check the welfare of the horses.
