Ophthalmic - menace response response normal both eyes. Reduced in the right eye PLR absent in both eyes. Right eye has severe cataracts. Left eye - keratitis and scleritis. There is a purulent discharge coming from the eye. Chronic changes to the left eye. Will likely not heal. Fluorescein stain NAD both eyes. FNA of mass under jaw - clear fluid. Cells washed off. Suspect that it is a neoplastic tumour. We cannot remove the tumour surgically, it will be palliative care. Dx: Bacterial eye infection, chronic changes to the eye. Suspected neoplasia of the jaw.
