Mr. Apollis took me to the back of the property where I observed 1x white and black pitbull x female called Mia, 1x black and white Husky x called Zoe and in a enclosure there is also 2x Huskies, 1x male called Max and 1x female called Sky. The 2x dogs in the enclosure body condition is acceptable but the pitbull x and husky x is underweight. The 2x Huskies in the enclosure does not have shelter, living area is also dirty with dog feaces lying all over. The owner Nathan Arendse was not at home. Mr. Apollis called Nathan's mom and she said that Mr. Apollis must sign over the 2x dogs that is underweight. Refer to admissions E2030, E2031. I issued warning W6282 to provide the 2x Huskies in the enclosure with adequate shelter and to clean the dogs living area. I also noted in my warning that I want to see if the dogs have food available on my next visit. Will follow up.
