General Report Comments: On my arrival to the property, I met Mr Tristan Bezuidenhout a care taker of the dogs according to him, he then contacted the owner and the owner arrived Mr Abraham Mc Quire, I then introduced myself and explained my visit to his property, I then gained access to his property, there I observed 2 Male+female Cocker spaniel dog breeds named Bella and other one named Yokeo, both of them were kept in an enclosure environment consisted with physical hazards such as working tools, and there was old feces lying on the floor.
The spaniels their coat appeared physically matted.

According to Mr Abraham, the spaniels were kept in an enclosure because they are fight with the 2 English bulldogs.

I also observed the 2 adult English bulldogs(3 years of age male named Uzzi and 5 years of age female named Honey), they were freely roaming inside the property, the 2 bulldogs appeared physically looking good, except that the female bulldog appeared physically having clinical health problems with its eyes(veterinary treatment for the eyes was available as eye flash drop and was applied twice daily according to Mr Abraham, shelter was in the form of dog kennels for each bulldogs and were put under the house varenders.

The 2 spaniel dogs also had a dog kennel place under the varenders.
I also observed 2 cats(tabby and black+white) both of cats appeared physically looking good in condition with no veterinary problems or health concerns. The cats were roaming freely inside the property.
I then issued Mr Abraham with a notice to comply, see notice no I005812.
