General Report Comments: I saw 1x brindle female terrier x on a short static chain without a collar. I stopped and called out,a lady who introduced herself as Mrs. Julies came out. I asked her why the dog called Mia is chained and she told it's because their property is not properly fenced. Mia is chained at the front of the house but away from her shelter. Mia's body condition is acceptable and her living space is clean. I also noticed that Mia's water bowl is dirty with algae present and asked Mrs. Julies to clean the water bowl. I issued warning W6277 to put Mia on a runner,to provide her with a collar,to install the runner in such a way that she can reach her shelter and to always make sure that Mia has fresh potable water available. Will follow up.
