The owner of the dog Mrs Nicole Joseph did also contacted the spca after hours phone from 0682153491 on the 11/07/2026 around 15H14 that her dog is sick and she contacted Sarah from animals welfare rescue in Laingville and Sarah advised her to contact the spca, as I was about to go attend the puppy complain I stopped at the filling station in Darling, and Mrs Nicole called the after hours phone again around 08H58 informed me that she will take the dog to Westland animal Hospital I must not come anymore.

After few hours, Sarah from Saint Helena Bay animals rescue, contacted the spca after hours phone around 14H15 that she requested Mrs Nicole Joseph to call the spca regarding her sick puppy that has been lying on the floor the whole day, and Sarah said the lady doesn't even have R200 of which she can't and will not afford to take the puppy to vet.

On my arrival to the property, the puppy was not physically showing any symptoms of sickness. I educated Mrs Alida that it will be good for the puppy to get vaccinated at the vet.
