General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the communal yard, the neighbours pointed me to the house believed to belong to the accused. A gentleman by the name, Gontse Maside who identified himself as the nephew of the accused, invited me in the yard to inspect the living condition of the dogs. There was a kennel and a static chain next to it. Water was found tipped over in a kitchen salad bowl. The bitch was found in the house nursing her younglings. The bitch "Milo" appeared to be in good physical condition. I offered Mr Maside to surrender the dogs to the Sandton SPCA but he refused. I offered free sterilization of the bitch but he said he consider it as soon as the mother recovers and the puppies are weaned. I asked Mr. Maside about the dog that allegedly bit the victim he said the dog does not live his house and might have been stolen or taken from Emmanuel's friends to have a stroll around him by the accused himself. Mr. Maside was issued with a warning to provide water for the dog and may never chain her in a position or manner to cause the dog to suffer unnecessarily. To do a random follow-up soon.
