General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the property, neighbours pointed me the owner's section of the yard. The owner's brother owns a hair salon and the dog was chained behind the salon, no water no shelter were provided and who the dog was in the care of his brother Chawanika Ndlovu. I advised him to sign over the dog to the Sandton SPCA but he told me that he needed to phone his brother first. We phoned his brother, Mr Sobala 'Socks' Ndlovu, explained to him the condition of the dog and my concerns. He told me that he will be coming back from work in 10 minutes. He arrived at the property few minutes later while we were in the hair salon with his brother walking with his dog off the chain using the chain as a lead. When I was busy talking to him he walked away saying he's taking the dog in some place else in Kew. I left him a warning with his brother who did not want to sign.
