Mr Mualaba admitted to the claims 'slapping' the dog because "Max" kept ripping down their washing but this is not a usual occurrence he was only frustrated because there was white clothing on the washing line to discipline the dog. We told him that this was not acceptable and we issued him with a written warning for his treatment towards the dog and to provide fresh, clean potable water at all times. We also offered him a free sterilization of the dog as part of our outreach program . He agreed to do so. To follow up with neutering the dog soon
