General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the property the owner of the property gave me access to conduct an inspection. Upon entry I found cross breed, female dog, black and tan colour. The dog appeared to be old and had very long overgrown nails. The dog was walking with difficulty because of old age and the overgrown nails. The owner said he was only getting an income every 3 months and could not immediately take the dog to a parlour or a vet to have her nails clipped. The dog's bedding was extremely dirty, smelly and torn. Never been washed for a while. The area where the owner and the dog were found under the veranda was dirty and full of urine stains, just not clean and never been hosed. The owner was asked about his dog that he brought and was euthanased at the SPCA. He told me that the dog had an ear infection and he had been trying to treat it with some ear infection medication but it just never made any difference. He said the dog wasn't that bad until I saw the photos and the video taken by either the vet or Maridza. The dog had maggots and it was still alive. I educated the owner that he would need to take his old dog to a vet or parlour to have her nails done. He said he could and would rather do it himself and I didn't have an issue with that. I also mentioned that he would need to wash the bedding and hose clean the veranda. As I was writing his warning letter he said he had decided to surrender the dog for euthanasia too. I gave him the forms and he completed them. He said he won't get any new dogs. He brought his dog to the vehicle and donated its food.
