General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the property I met with the owner of the cat for the very first time. I introduced myself to him and explained why I was there. I told him that I had tried to contact him about his cat and that I had never received any communication from anyone asking about how the cat was doing even when they have signed over for treatment. He didn't look concerned and asked if what was he supposed to do? I asked him what happened to the cat and he told me that he didn't know and that there was no treatment sought for it. I told him this was extremely wrong that the cat had to go through pain and unnecessary suffering that they could have prevented had they called SPCA or taken the cat to a vet but still he did appear to be interested. He told me he was going to church for his prayer. I told him I was issuing him with a warning. He told me I can keep the cat. I gave him a form to sign and surrender the cat to the Sandton SPCA. As I was busy writing the warning he told me that he was really going and he said he will sign the warning and that I should give it to his sister. He signed and after completing the warning I handed it over to his sister. In this matter, I realized that Mr Ramazani did not show any remorse for his failure to provide treatment. I had also communicated with the complainant and she told me that the cat was not the first cat that had been neglected at the shop. She said everytime they replace cats at the premises. I therefore consider prosecuting the owner for contravention of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962.
