General Report Comments: Upon arrival on scene the chickens were all confined in crates and ready to be loaded into the bakkie. Some were already in the bakkie. We discovered that the strapping rope broke off and some of the crates with chickens inside fell off on the the road. Luckily none were injured upon inspection. There was another vehicle that arrived to assist with lessening the load from the one bakkie. We assisted with carrying the crates and movement to the other vehicle. Both vehicles were escorted to their destination at 62 Clacton Road, Kensington, Johannesburg. They were all off loaded there and fed as well as being provided with water.

The chickens were offloaded into a garage and a sheltered area. They appeared to be in good physical condition. They were also exhausted but responded positively to food, water and were able to stand as well move.

A warning was issued to the owner educating him to ensure that he transport chickens in a suitable manner and that he doesn't overload the vehicle.
