General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the property the following observations were recorded :-

1.
 - Gorilla, German shepherd had problems with hips
 - Million, Rottweiler, had problems with teeth 'discoloration'
 - Ceaser, brown Boerboel, had hip problems and difficulty in standing
 - Mungo, Gsd, had discoloration of teeth.
 - Shakira, German shepherd, had a lump or swelling under the left eye.
 - Klipper, a Rottweiler, black and tan had lump on front left leg. No medical records were presented.
 - Alaska, Swiss Shepherd has fly strike on ears and skin condition on muzzle.
 - Zone, German shepherd, appeared to have an injury on his mouth.
2. The place was short of fly traps and there were fly traps inside the kennel rows that were attacking flies more closer to the dogs.
3. The kennels were cleaned with water only and not detergent was used. There was dirt found under the bed boards and in some instances there was excess water in the kennels.
4. Not all kennels were fitted with bed boards.
5. All the dogs had choke chains on them even inside the kennels.
6. The diets, pet meance was attractive flies and pap was being cooked. In some in kennels there were bones found.
7. There was an old and rusted trailer in the training ground.
8. There were some old dogs that were no longer used and kept in the kennels, not retired.
9. Evidence of protruding wires was noticed in the in the outside kennels.
10. There were food bowls with sharp edges.
11. The disinfectant sprays placed outside each kennel row were not working.
12. The PAPA was available upon request.
13. The medical records of each animal were not available.
14. The filing system of the animals and their records was poorly managed.
15. We discovered that animals were working 7 days without being rested
16. The dip bath was dirty. The water had not been changed.
17. We watched how the dogs were trained.

Written warnings were issued requesting that the above highlighted concerns be rectified .
