The dogs had access to potable water even though I told to move the containers away from direct sunlight. There was an asbestos kennel with a broken back support placed bare along the driveway with no waterproof base that he claimed he always puts a blanket for them in the veranda. I asked him to buy a proper kennel or lean the one he has against the wall of the veranda so that adequate shelter is provided in a protected place. For the old sick, I convinced him to surrender the dog to be put down because he was obviously out pain or the frustration of the parasites all over his body. He agreed to do so after signing my Warming no. WG 0558. The dog was surrendered while we make arrangements for next week for the remaining dog to be neutered.
