He said that the dog was left by the owner 4 days ago and now the house was sold to a new owner. I requested the dog owners from Mr Ramadhani's colleague, Dieu Merci, who works nightshift through phoning him. He gave me the dog owner's name and contacts, Mr Charles Samuriwo 084 246 9216 who was unreachable when I contacted him several times and I even texted him on WhatsApp. The guard on duty said he was receiving dog food handouts from concerned members of the public and he was running out of dog food. The yard was bushy and had overgrown grass and the dog was likely to pick up external parasites if I he was to be left in such an environment. The dog appeared to be in a fairly acceptable physical condition. Because the dog was potentially going to be starved, I didn't see the reason to leave the dog any longer. I had to phone the UGS security site manager Mr Charles on 081 371 8029 who granted permission for me to impound the dog and have the owner deal with us directly. The dog was impounded for a period 7 days due to possible abandonment. To await owner's claim within 7 days.
