General Report Comments: Arrived at the Estate and met the estate manager, Mr. Lovemore Dlamini. Mr Dlamini said that they have been owning the birds, the 4 Caribbean/American flamingos since 1993 specially imported with a permit by the previous Estate owners. He claimed that the birds may have been sterilized as they remained only 4 and never flew anywhere even in breeding season. They are kept in a built-up aerated pond enriched with trees(natural shelter) arching over as cover for the birds. The pond contained the khoi fish (as detailed) and resident African black ducks. They have an aquatic expert from Koi Medic that comes to water test and do general checks on the animals once every year in September. He said that the light is on at the night and it is also used to deter cats and other predators. He said that the birds will always take cover in unbearable times. Food is also supplied and is also made available at all times. The animals appeared to be in acceptable physical condition. No violation of the Animals Protection Act was found.
