General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the garden site, the complainant insisted that they wanted to be there. One of the caretakers who works at the garden site but lives at the Frog Pond, opened the gate for me. The place runs a landscaping company that also shares the space with the caretakers residing on the property. They have animals (as listed) which we've been visiting over the years when we receive complaints. There were dogs(3), chickens, sheep and a Guinea fowl. The 2 of the 3 dogs appeared to be in acceptable physical condition, with shelter and water made available. Adequate shelter was also available for the dogs but the blanket used for them was dirty and appeared to be wet. The sheep enclosure was not roofed and did not provide adequate protection from harsh weather. The chicken coop was dirty and in infested with parasites (fleas). I told him that the Guinea fowl is also not allowed to be kept unless there is a valid permit issued to them. I advised him that the above-mentioned issues need to be be addressed with his boss within 7 days of my visit. The old dog was found in a listless state, emaciated and appeared to be mangy. The dog euthanized at the gate of the property with the of the owner Mr. Charles Tshabalala to hold down his dog. I even recommended products(wrote them down for him) for defleaing the coop and the surroundings. To follow up in 7 days.
