General Report Comments: I arrived at the property and met the owner and complainant, Ms. Grady Mukuna who showed me that the dog had been thrown with a brick over their wall by an unidentified person. The brick is suspected to have landed on the dog's leg but no one saw it when it happened. They found the dog the next morning with a swollen leg. According to Ms. Mukuna and her mother, the dog had been given pain medication an hour prior to my arrival by someone who works at the Brumalake Vet Clinic who charged them R250 as they had no money to take the dog to the vet. She told them that the dog was going to be okay because its leg 'was not broken'. They didn't present me with any proof that substantiate their claims. The dog was still able walk but on a limp during my inspection. I spoke to regarding the seriousness of the injury and gave them options to take the dog to the vet immediately, take the dog to our clinic but make plans to come fetch the dog if they can't afford a private vet or let me do it or sign over the dog to the Sandton SPCA as a surrender. They were not willing to do any of my options saying we are situated very far from them. They insisted that the dog will be treated by the same person with pain medication. The other dog appeared to be in acceptable physical condition. I issued a written warning to them to take the dog to a veterinarian and forward us with Veterinary Report as proof of treatment by a vet. To follow up
