General Report Comments: Upon arrival at the property, the owner's spouse came to the gate saying his husband was not home because they are of Ivory Coast national and her English is not good. I asked her to contact him and she did so. She said her husband will be home in a few minutes. I waited and the husband finally arrived. He invited me to enter the house to show me around his yard. He owns a 1-year-2-month-old, black and tan neutered male, German Shepherd Dog which appeared to be in acceptable physical condition. Water and shelter were adequately available. I asked him about him about providing a comfortable resting place but he said he had been buying cushions that went on to even cost R5 000 that were destroyed by the dog. The dog was so destructive that it damaged his car costing him at least 10 grand to do the repairs. The dog gets taken to the Edenglen Vet for veterinary care. The dog appeared to be be pacing and tail-chasing and when I asked him about it he said that he was told that it is normal in dogs according to an animal behaviourist, named Nicki Elliott from Animal Think tank where he took the dog to be trained one Saturday. He said he was told that when puppies are separated from their mother at a young age they tend to behave this way. The owner bought toys and cattle bones for the dog to play with during the day. The dog barks at people and other dogs outside the gate out of curiosity. No elements of compromised animal welfare were found.
