General Report Comments: The house was rented out to multiple tenants and I was invited to the house by the landlord. He took me to the tenant in question, Mr Farai Chinomwe (068 510 6948) where we found him outside his caravan trailer with his dog tied up to iron post with a light-duty cargo strap. There was a bowl filled with food but the water bowl was empty. The dog was provided with a duvet inner for sleeping outside the caravan with no adequate shelter provided. The owner claimed that the dog sleeps inside with him and his family. The landlord wanted the dog taken out of his property as he did not consent to it. I advised him to find an alternative place for the dog. I tried convincing him to surrender the dog and perhaps come back to adopt the dog but he was adamant to do so. He did admit to have locked the dog in a his car with no ventilation as the doors were closed shut. I issued him with a written Warning to rectify these issues within 7 days. To follow up in 7 days
