General Report Comments: When I arrived at the property, the owner's were told me that they were at the gym when whole incident happened. They claim this was caused by the dogs being walked past their gate which their own dogs to bark at them but one of them accidentally bumped into the other being the Pitbull named "Elvis" thinking this may have provoked "Elvis" who then retaliated with a vicious and fatal attack toward the Dachshund named "Oscar" who was taken to the Parkview Vet in a critical condition before I arrived. They said one of their close neighbours contacted them about the incident and they rushed back home to find this tragedy. I asked them to view the dogs' living conditions which I was shown. The remaining 5 dogs were in acceptable physical condition even though the Pitbull was still covered in blood on his muzzle down his neck. I gave them a warning advising them the dangers of the Pitbull going forward now that he has tasted blood, by advising them about having too many dogs on the property in terms of the By-laws and to forward me the Veterinary Report for the attack victim dog, "Oscar" when the vet has had him examined. I engaged with the owners to surrender the dog to the Sandton SPCA but they said they were not comfortable doing so in the fear of the dog being euthanized. They tried other Rescue organizations to take the Pitbull to while I was still talking to them but they didn't seem to be getting anywhere with it. I gave them an opportunity to still consider surrendering the dog to us and phone me if they ever decide to do so. To follow up with them regarding the vet report
