General Report Comments: I arrived at the property where I found a gentleman named Spark renting out the main house. He informed me that Nadia was not home but I can go ahead to her cottage at the back. I found 2 and later the third daughter came back from school. One of the daughters showed me to the back where I found the dog chained to a gate post of a back passage way with black fabric collar and a chained leash of about a meter long. There were 2 empty feeding bowl, and water bowls(saucepan). No shelter protecting the dog from weather elements. I phoned the owner Nadia, but it doesn't go through. There were kittens(2) being fed kitten food in the house but one young kitten was being fed milk according to the daughters. I advised them to stop feeding the kittens milk and rather kitten formula because it was starting to wean off breastmilk. I was joined later by the father of the girls at the property, Mr Cyril Assibong who said he didn't give anyone consent to take the dog. He said that there was shelter, a wooden kennel destroyed by his landlord in a way to get rid of the dog. He said the dog had been there from the over a year but because there are new tenants trying to move into the next vacant cottage the dog is now an inconvenience for her. I tried persuading Mr Assibong to sign over the dog to us but he was not ready to do that he'd better find another place for the dog. He said he will be taking his dog to a waste shop on 11 Hospital Road, Cleveland. He mentioned to have more dogs(Pitbulls) at the shop. I will be following up on the 5/10/2023
