General Report Comments: I joined forces with an Environmental Health Practitioner, Mr Wellborn Chauke when we found the inspection. Upon arrival at the premises, Mr Spitalnik gave us access to conduct the follow-up inspection. He was busy fixing the roof for the animal enclosure. The chicken run was improved with housekeeping. The parasites were reduced after I recommended the use of Karbadust™ for every cleaning cycle. The sheep and goats were enclosure was still lacking adequate shelter. Similar case remained with the equine. There was still no shelter constructed/erected for the horses and donkeys. They were kept in a small place in both their enclosures with only a green shade cloth merely covering overhead. The amount of flies multiplied since moving into the property and that's another reason of the complaint. The flies were infested to the extent of biting the donkeys' legs causing a serious irritation. Their legs were so irritated that they were losing hair on them out of constant scratching. They resorted to remain in a sitting position. Mr Spitalnik told me that he he's been applying some Neem oil on the legs to treat the legs but I told him that the flies will still become infested due to the size of the enclosure that only limits the donkeys to circle around in the same small place. I issued a written Warning to the owners to get these issues sorted urgently. He said that they belong to his Dr. Dean Gersun who said that his animals will be taken to a in Vereeniging when I contacted him later. Mr Spitalnik assured me that he would get a vet out to check the donkeys and immediately called the vet in my presence before I left the house. To follow up on the donkeys in 10 days.
