General Report Comments: I conducted Stable inspection on the 16/07/2024 after received complaint about the condition of the horses. The following were my findings: 1. 17 horses observed in the Paddock which 4 X of them appeared to be underweight (moderate) conditions ribs visible narrow neck ,dull coat. The stable dirty with no bedding just urine observed in the stable. The tack was just left on the floor .Concentrate food not enough for the amount of horses in that condition as there were only three half bags .2. 118 layers chickens observed 4 x chickens appeared to be sick, kept in a battery hen system, two of them had eye infection one had a broken upper beak another one had a deep wound on the rump no adequate shelter. Owner instructed to surrender them which he did chickens were humanely put to sleep. I observed 6 x New Zealand white confined on mesh wire cages no bedding, one kitten found dead and was still in the cage.

A warning was issued for all the above concerns .The owner of the horses was not around during my visit but I spoke to him telephonically and a warning was issued as well.

On my observation there is poor management towards the animals in this plot and lack of supervision. A follow up inspections was conducted on the 24/07/2024 and I have noticed that more bales of eragrostis and the stable was clean with bedding a follow up inspection will be conducted. A follow up inspection was conducted at Qurtuba Petting farm as we conducted inspection on theThe petting farm is still under construction which was part of our recommendations after our previous inspection, to improve the living condition of the animals in their care. The petting farm consist of the following animals; 5 x Dexter cattle, 3 emuse, 8 Horses, 2 donkeys, 2 Alpaca, 2 Llama, 53 Goats and 4 Camels. All animals appeared to be in good physical condition with the provision of water and food according to animal speceis and breed specifications. Some of animals still dont have adequate shelter as the enclosure is still under construction. Anysa Pillay (General Manager) and Project Manager Nabil Peer were issued with a warning to speed up the construction process. A follow up inspection will be conducted to check the improvement. We were told that it can take four weeks.
