General Report Comments: When I arrived at the Litte Paradise Preschool, I spoke to one of the preschool workers who said the property has 2 separate houses and the house in question is at the back but she couldn't let me into the house of without the owner's permission. She gave me the owner's contact details, and I phoned the owner. I got a hold of the owner, (Dr) Anthony Samuel who told me that he was on his way home he will see me shortly. He finally arrived and we went to his house. He was keeping a 3-month-old, tan, female Cross Breed puppy in a cage (made of steel metal sheet and painted black). There was also a 3-year-old, black and tan, neutered male Rottweiler kept in a car port area. Both living enclosures were dirty, untidy and unhygienic. The puppy was kept with bags of fertilizers that I told him remove from the cage and he may not keep the cage locked. The owner stated that he is keeping the dogs caged because the school children also make use of the same yard to play and do activities. He said the preschool owner is renting the premises from him and will be moving out in December. The puppy was immediately released from being confined in a cage while he attempted to reassure me that he always allows the dogs to roam free when preschool kids are no longer on the property. I issued the owner a written warning for his actions and suggested that he partition the yard into 2 parts – back and front. I told him I'd be returning next week to check on his progress and whether cleaning for the dogs is done.
