General Report Comments: I phoned the complainant to get the correct address details. The complainant directed us to an address 56 – 7th Avenue, Alexandra and said we must ask for a lady named Elinah when we emailed them, Sr Inspector Ronald and I went to the property to investigate the matter based on the allegations made by the complainant. We met a gentleman named Lephayi Maake who identified himself as the owner of the dogs (2) that he keeps in his single-roomed house. His yard is only a passageway of no more 5 x 1,2 m (approximately less than 10 m²) shared with few of his neighbours. He was keeping 2 adult dogs in a designed wooden bed base that had door. The dogs were confined under the three quarter (¾) bed. He claimed to love dogs and said he was keeping them locked whenever he has visitor over to his place. I explained to Mr Maake that the dogs may not be kept in a small place and that he did not have an adequate place to keep the dogs as he was sharing the yard with his neighbours. He claimed to take the dogs out sometimes even though we found locked up. He told him to find an alternative suitable place with more space to allow freedom of unobstructed movement because he would not surrender the dogs when we offered him that option. He would not listen to any our advice, and he rudely started to tell us to leave his place he needed to go back to work. He left us at next to his house while we still talking to him locking the dogs inside. We amicably left the property after educating about him proper care of dogs
