General Report Comments: Upon follow-up inspection, the goats were never taken to the vet. Treatment of the goats was done on site but through her 16-year experience using the available medication, according to Mrs Tomic. We proceeded to see the goats and found that their health condition had improved since our last visit. The red-headed & white goat including the red nannies were no longer limping and they were actively feeding normally with the rest of the herd. The red nanny was treated with antibiotics and the white & red-headed one was dipped into the Coopers™ Triatex bath to get rid of parasites that caused hair loss on the goat according to the owner. We did see some progress in the running pens where new patches of grass had been laid down. We issued Mrs Tomic with a warning telling her that she may not treat animals herself unless under the vet's instructions and prescribed medicine that is still within expiry period. The property will form part of our monthly proactive/routine inspections to ensure minimum standards of keeping livestock are adhere to.
