After the inspection, I informed Raficky that I would meet with Mohammed (owner of the bull) to address the issues identified. Later that day, I met with Mohammed and issued a formal warning regarding the following: The necessity of keeping the gate closed and locked to prevent future escapes. The requirement for constant supervision of the cattle by his staff especially when grazing outside the property . The need to repair the damaged fence to ensure the safety and security of the animals. The importance of maintaining a clean environment by regularly picking up plastic and other debris. Food, water and shelter is provided for the Bull
