General Report Comments: 1. No wildbeest seen during inspection and I was informed by Zoo staff members that they do not have wildebeest at the Johannesburg Zoo.

2. During the inspection I did not observe unhygienic conditions or flies surrounding the ducks. The ducks(Yellow- Billed ducks x 4, Red-crested pochard ducks x5) they appeared to have adequate food, water, shelter and enrichment. Some of the ducks were even playing in the man-made water pond. And some of the ducks I saw them free-roaming in the zoo facility.

3. The baboons we observed were kept in hygienic conditions with access to food, water, shelter and enrichment. I further requested to go at the back section to see the sleeping enclosures which appeared to be acceptable and I saw enrichment inside the baboons sleeping sections. I inspected Black crested Mangabey Baboons, Mona Monkey, Diana Monkey, De-Brazza Monkey, L'Hoest Monkey, Black crested Mangabey. We did not observe any monkeys that appeared sad or agitated .

4. I was informed that the zoo has a rat control program in place. I did not observe any rats during our inspection routine check.

5. We did not observe any ducks with inadequate shelter . I have requested from the complainant to provide more specific details or photos or location if possible , Some of the ducks were free-roaming in the Zoo facility. Somewhere kept in the enclosures(e.g Yellow-Billed ducks, Red-crested pochard ducks). I was informed by the staff their ducks do have man-made shelter and natural shelters like "trees" which they showed me.

6. Our inspection of the elephants x 3(Lammie female +41 years, Ramadiba female + 28 years, Mupani male + 25 years) did not reveal any signs of injury when we conducted an inspection, While we acknowledge that confinement can be a source of stress, we require more solid proof and expert opinion regarding the elephants emotional state.

7. We did not observe any dead birds during our inspection and the staff informed me that they were not aware of any dead birds however if they see any dead animals they take it away and inform their vet.

8.I have requested from the complainant to provide more specific details photos or video evidence this will assist me to build a solid case with facts. And specify which enclosure appeared to be in a state of disrepair and provide photographic evidence or direction location for us to go back check this enclosure
