General Report Comments: I first went to the victim's house to get their statement on what happened. Their address is 20 The Curve Avenue, Observatory. The house appeared to be dilapidated. I found a lady named Nelisiwe Mtshali(no contact details), who said she was not there when the incident happened, as she only found their puppy dead. She stated that the puppy was then taken away by someone named Kenny, and he doesn't know where they took it. She had a very old dog that appeared to have muscle or joint ailments, as seen by the way the dog was walking. I persuaded her to surrender the dog because she clearly could not afford a vet, as she was unemployed. She signed over the dog. Ad # AA5/5.

I proceeded to the address in question, 64 Observatory Avenue, Observatory. Mr Themba Gwizi granted me access into the premises where I found them owning 4 adults dogs and 11 puppies of 2 different bitches. The dogs had shelter in a covered area and a veranda for sleeping. There were bowls of water points around the yard for drinking. Mr Gwizi admitted that one of his dogs had sneaked through the fence and bitten a neighbour's dog, but went to speak to the owners even though other agitated neighbours were interfering. He said the fence was still being repaired for damages. He said they have just moved in to the premises reopen their business and they were in a process of doing renovations. He said they were still problems operating the business with red-tapes in the area. I tried convincing the owner Mr Sipiwe Ndebele to sign over some of the dogs but he said still needs to allocate them at some of his properties and plans to have them sterilized but he will get back to me as soon as he decides to let go of some of the dogs. I will contact him in the middle of May
